SUBJECT: Parking on the Texas Christian University Campus

- 🍏 - Place your PSIA Parking ID slip on the dashboard of your car. The ID is **not** mandatory, but it does help to identify your vehicle and its purpose on the campus. Security is tighter on university campuses these days, and we want to do everything possible to ensure correct identification of vehicles sponsored by PSIA.
- 🍏 - On Saturday at the TCU campus, you may park in any space that is not restricted by the words AT ALL TIMES or HANDICAPPED, or by time specifications. All other spaces are open on Saturdays. Parking lots are adjacent to the buildings in which the tournament will be held. All buildings in which contests will be held are in close proximity to each another. The most ample parking may be found in the Brown-Lupton Student Center parking lot, located just behind our PSIA headquarters in Dave Reed Hall.
- 🍏 - Buses should unload students near the buildings in which students are competing, then park in one of the parking lots, unless otherwise directed by a DPS officer.
