

SENIOR EXAMINATION EXEMPTION
2007 - 2008

In order to qualify for an exemption from taking a spring semester examination in any individual course, a senior must meet the following requirements in that course and the general stipulations on a semester basis.

CONDUCT:

A grade of an "S" for each nine weeks is required. (Each conduct grade is independent of others.)

ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE:

An academic grade no lower than an 80 on third and fourth nine-week report cards is required.

ATTENDANCE:

No more than eight non-school related absences (not counting toward the eight are doctor appointments with notes and college visits with completed Pre-Arranged Student Absence form prior to visit). Excessive tardiness can result in loss of senior exemption.

GENERAL STIPULATIONS:

1. Students receiving a suspension from school (either in-school or out-of-school) will be required to take all semester exams.
2. Required Community Service project hours must be turned in and approved no later than April 4, 2008.
3. Excessive detentions can result in a student losing their exemption status.
